In 2020, *Hofesh Shechter’s Clowns* was presented globally online and won Best International Short Dance Film at CHOREOSCOPE – The International Dance Film Festival of Barcelona. Shechter II plans a return to live theatre audiences with *POLITICAL MOTHER UNPLUGGED* and will feature in a new short dance film for summer release. Hofesh Shechter’s new creation *Double Murder* and *LIGHT: Bach Dances* will also premiere in this year.
